Aventurine class trip - Cheddar Gorge Thursday 6th June 2019

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our topic next term 'Tremors' we plan to take the children to Cheddar Gorge in Somerset to explore all it has to offer.

The day is packed full of hands on learning experiences.

A Gough's Cave tour is included and covers the formation not only of the caves but of the Gorge and the limestone hills it is cut from. In the Diamond chamber the guide will be able to point out evidence of the earthquake which destroyed the first church on Glastonbury Tor in 1275.

Another part of the tour features exploring the unique eco-system which caused Cheddar Gorge to be declared a Site of Special Scientific Interest with a mass of rare flora, insects, birds and animals - including nine different types of bat. There is also a field work OS map reading session where the children will be able to use a compass to help them complete a field work study.

We plan to leave Cornhill at 9:00am and so the children are to arrive on time at the usual school start time.

We will be back in Stroud by 4:30pm (traffic depending).

Your child will need a packed lunch with plenty to drink (please note no fizzy drinks or glass bottles) and they will need to wear their school uniform with suitable footwear.

The cost for the trip per child will be £18.00.
