Progress Scores

National progress scores for all pupils is 0.

Reading	+3.18	+0.7	This score demonstrates that SVCS reading score was significantly above the national progress score.
Writing	+4.06	-1.1	This score demonstrates that SVCS writing score was significantly above the national progress score and in the top 10% of schools.

Average Scale Score

A scaled score enables test results to be reported consistently from one year to the next. Though national tests are designed to be as similar as possible every year in terms of demand, slight differences do occur. Scaled scores, however, maintain their meaning over time, so if two children achieve the same scaled score on two different tests, they will have demonstrated the same attainment. In the new scaled score for the national tests, 100 will always represent the 'national standard'.
