





REPORT FROM FULL GOVERNING BODY MEETING 5/2/18

From May this year there are new General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) coming into place and it was discussed how the school will ensure they meet these. The school will team up with other local schools to help share the cost of hiring an expert to assist with ensuring these new regulations are met.

Governor Visits - Parent Governor Phil Taylor, sang his praises for the recent Young Voices concert at the NEC. The school was part of a concert where 6500 children sang in a choir, performing pop songs as part of a professional concert. Thanks and acknowledgment for the extra time the staff put in to make this possible.

A report of the Teaching, Learning & Achievement committee meeting was given where, after an analysis of the SAT's data, the general areas to focus on are Key Stage 1 Reading and Key Stage 2 Maths. Parents will be encouraged to have their say by completing Parent Voice questionnaires at the upcoming parents' evenings on 12th, 14th & 15th March. Policies were looked at and ratified (these can be found on the school website under information) - Equality and Conflict Resolution Policies. Phil Taylor will become the Equality link governor, where he will meet with Debbie Sleep periodically to review the policy and see how it's being implemented.

Safeguarding - it was noted that the governors on the Behaviour and Safety committee have read through the relevant parts (Keeping Children Safe Part 2) of the documents.


Christine Barrett, gave a mid year report on the special educational needs and disability (SEND) within the school. Training has been provided for all 1:1 T.A.s on a new ICT programme called Clicker 7 which can help children with their literacy.

All children have now been moved from previous statements to Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCP).
