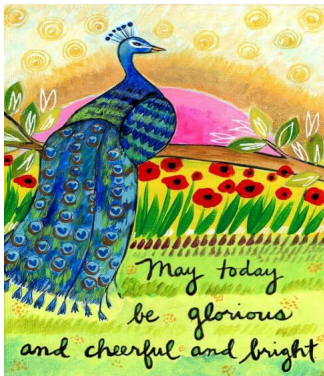

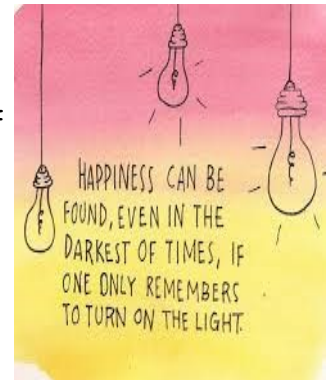


VALUES TREE
