ATTENDANCE— SUCCESS STARTS BY BEING AT SCHOOL

You may have seen recent government plans to raise attainment in schools nationally. This is reflected in our school with attendance being a significant issue. Currently our whole school attendance is below the national average at 91% with the latest national figure being 94%.

Children attending less than 90% of the school year, are monitored as being persistently absent. Your child's school reports will identify this for you this year.

Attendance is part of the school development plan and will be monitored by the governors.

Following a meeting that Miss Sleep was called to attend with the local authority, parents will be expected to do the following:

- work with the school and local authority to help them understand their child's barriers to attendance.
- proactively engage with the formal support offered - including any parenting contract or voluntary early help plan to prevent the need for legal intervention.

IT ALL ADDS UP!

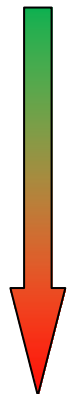
Attending school everyday gives your child the best chance of success **100%**

Attending **4 1/2 days** a week = **4 weeks** learning missed per year **90%**

Attending **4 days** a week = **8 weeks** learning missed per year **80%**

Attending **3 1/2 days** a week = **12 weeks** learning missed per year **70%**

80% attendance adds up to missing 2 full years of education over your child's school life.



EVERY MINUTE COUNTS

Being late for school reduces learning time. Arriving late can be very disruptive for your child, the teacher and other children in the class.

5 minutes late every day = **3 days** of learning missed per year

15 minutes late every day = **9 days** of learning missed per year
