Book Tokens will be given to the children on Monday. The £1 tokens can be swapped for one of the new and completely free World Book Day books available from participating booksellers, or used to get £1 off any full price book or audiobook instead (as long as the book or audiobook costs at least £2.99).

The tokens will also be accepted at all major UK supermarkets, including Asda, Tesco, Morrisons, Sainsbury's, and most large bookshop chains including WHSmith, Waterstones, and Eason.

The World Book Day £1 book tokens cannot be used for online purchases.

PARKING PERMITS

PLANNED ROAD CLOSURES

Severn Trent are due to begin upgrade works on the sewerage network within the Stroud area in Autumn 2021, in order to reduce future sewer flooding and pollution. First of all, they need to carry out site investigation works, which will be beginning on week commencing **15 March 2021** on Nelson Street, followed by work on Middle Street and Acre Street. In order to keep our team and the public safe, they will need to implement a rolling road closure. Please bear this in mind when planning your journey to and from school.
