We've planned a trip to 'STEAM' the railway museum in Swindon to help us start our new topic 'The Railway Revolution' in an exciting and engaging way!

Date – Monday 8th November.

Cost – £16 (£10 per ticket, which includes entry to STEAM and an educational workshop and £6 per child for the coach journey).

The children will have an opportunity to using original objects, unique railway artefacts, costume and role play pupils investigate why and how the railways were built, with a focus on the Great Western region. Explore the life and achievements of inspirational engineers, Isambard Kingdom Brunel and George and Robert Stephenson, by bringing these characters to life. Retell the story of early locomotives like Locomotion, Rocket and North Star.

The trip will take place within the school day and so children are to arrive and be collected at the usual times with a packed lunch.
