

Stroud Valley Community Primary School – Uniform Policy



We believe that wearing a school uniform helps children to concentrate, behave well and to feel part of the school family. It has a positive effect on their learning. Uniform with the Stroud Valley logo on can be purchased via the website www.myclothing.com or from Batemans Sports shop in Stroud. We also have a supply of good second-hand uniforms – please email the office. School uniform comprises:

- Grey or black skirt, trousers, shorts or pinafore (not jeans)
- White or green shirt, t-shirt or polo shirt
- Green sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan
- Green and white checked dress – for summer
- Black or brown sensible shoes – it's hard, and dangerous, to skip in heels! Please make sure your child can fasten their own shoes.

- PE kit comprises:
 - Pair of shorts or jogging bottoms
 - Coloured T-shirt to match your child's PE house (Red, Blue, Green or Yellow)
 - Black plimsolls (EYFS/Key Stage One)
 - Trainers (Key Stage Two)
 - PE bag - find something unusual or customise your child's bag so they can find it easily.

If it's wet and your child wears wellies they also need to bring indoor shoes and a named peg to keep their wellies together. Jewellery is not allowed. If your child has pierced ears they should wear studs in school and will need to take them out themselves for swimming and PE.
