

Dear Parents of Quartz children,

In Term 6, we have arranged for the children to visit Cotswold Wildlife Park on **Thursday 20th June** as part of their science topic on habitats and adaptations.

It will be a truly wonderful day in which the children will take part in a talk all about habitats and adaptations, have chance to visit all the animals around the park and take a trip on the Cotswold Wildlife Park train.

Entry to the park itself is amazing value for money. What costs the most for us as a school to take children on these immersive trips are the coach costs.

We would really like to keep costs for you down and keep the trip to **£16** per child. In order to do this, as a class we need to raise **£162**.

We have come up with two activities to help us raise the money.
