## YEAR 5 RESIDENTIAL 2024

This will take place from 16<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> October at Hooke Court in Dorset. This is an annual trip for the Year 5's who always have a wonderful time. Both staff and children are very impressed with the activities on offer, as well as the accommodation and facilities. Although there are similar centres closer to Gloucestershire, they proved to be more expensive and did not offer the same kind of experience.

We plan to take the children to Hooke Court from Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> October to Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2024 when they begin Year 5. Hooke Court has a range of exciting on-site activities which are both fun and educational, providing maximum benefit for everyone who undertakes them. They have been designed to enhance and complement the National Curriculum as well as develop team work, communication and negotiation skills and improve personal confidence. Attached to this letter is a copy of an itinerary to give you an idea of the activities on offer. Also attached is a kit list so that you have an idea of clothes etc. your child will need to take with him / her.

The cost for a three-day, two-night stay will be £195 which will cover the cost of all meals (cooked breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal), accommodation, use of all facilities, a full range of organised activities (both day and evening), the coach fare and insurance. The children will also be able to take £5 spending money with them.

We will require a deposit of at least £25, which we would ask for by June 28<sup>th</sup> but the rest can be paid in instalments, up to September 16th, when the full amount must be paid. Our preferred method of payment is by ParentPay, but if you really would rather not do this, then please send cash or cheque (payable to Stroud Valley School) to the office. If you do not already have a ParentPay account and would like to set one up please ask the office for your log-in details.

If you are going through a period of financial difficulty, please don't hesitate to contact the office where we have details of an educational charity which may be able to help with some funding for those children whose families are on a low income.

## Essential Items for a stay at Hooke Court

Clothing and shoes worn outside during activities will inevitably get dirty – so old clothes are best! We try to help children look after their things, but items regularly get lost or left behind. We therefore strongly recommend that you name all items of clothing – and provide your child with a packing list, so that he/she can check items back into their bag.

Please use the following checklist to help pack bags:

- 1 Bath towel
- Toiletries bag containing: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush etc.
- Night clothes
- Socks and underwear
- T-shirts, shirts / blouses (at least 1 with long-sleeves)
- Thick sweater + light sweater, sweat shirt
- Pairs of trousers and/or jeans and/or tracksuit bottoms and/or shorts and/or skirts
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)
- Sturdy shoes or wellingtons (even in summer; particularly necessary for river studies)
- 1 pair of trainers
- Torch
- Large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Gloves, hat, scarf (in winter)
- Sun hat and cream (in summer)
- Water Bottle
- Lunch for Day One

\* Please note that most outdoor activities require long sleeves and long trousers even in the summer to protect legs and arms from scratches, ticks etc.
