We're very excited to announce that we have been awarded **GOLD** for our Artsmark award.



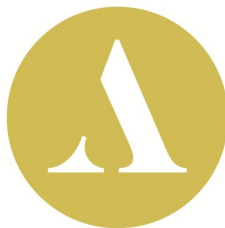

Sad news

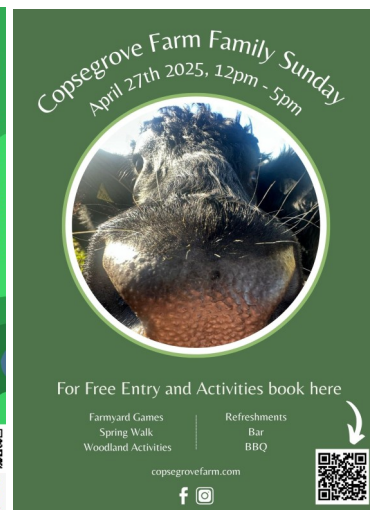
