School Trip - Aventurine Class Visit to the Museum in the Park

Date: Tuesday 17th June 2025

As part of our 'Local History' topic, we will be visiting the Museum in the Park to study the cloth-making industry in the Stroud Valleys. It promises to be a very interesting and informative trip, featuring map and photo investigations, a historical trail, and a spinning and weaving demonstration led by a specialist from the Stroudwater Textile Trust.

The cost of the trip is £6.50 per child, which covers the museum experience and the workshop led by a local expert.

Students should arrive at school as normal for registration in Aventurine Class. We will then walk to the museum together.
